

2018 – NOMINATION GUIDELINES

John Laing Professional Development Awards

Principals Australia Institute developed the L5 Leadership Framework: 'A resource for building leadership in schools' in 2004 to assist school leaders to analyse and reflect on personal and professional aspects of leadership roles.

The L5 Framework has close connections with key aspects of the National Professional Standard for Principals. Principals can use the L5 Framework to support them in building leadership capacity in their schools.

The L5 Framework is comprised of five statements:

1. Leadership starts from within	Leaders have a clear personal vision about their capacity for efficacy
2. Leadership is about influencing others	Leaders have a charter to inspire, support and encourage staff and students
3. Leadership develops a rich learning environment	Leaders create opportunities for staff and students to achieve in their teaching and learning
4. Leadership builds professionalism and management capacity	Leaders develop structures and processes to assist the school to deliver quality education
5. Leadership inspires leadership actions and aspirations in others	Leaders empower and build capacity in staff and students for taking on roles and responsibilities
